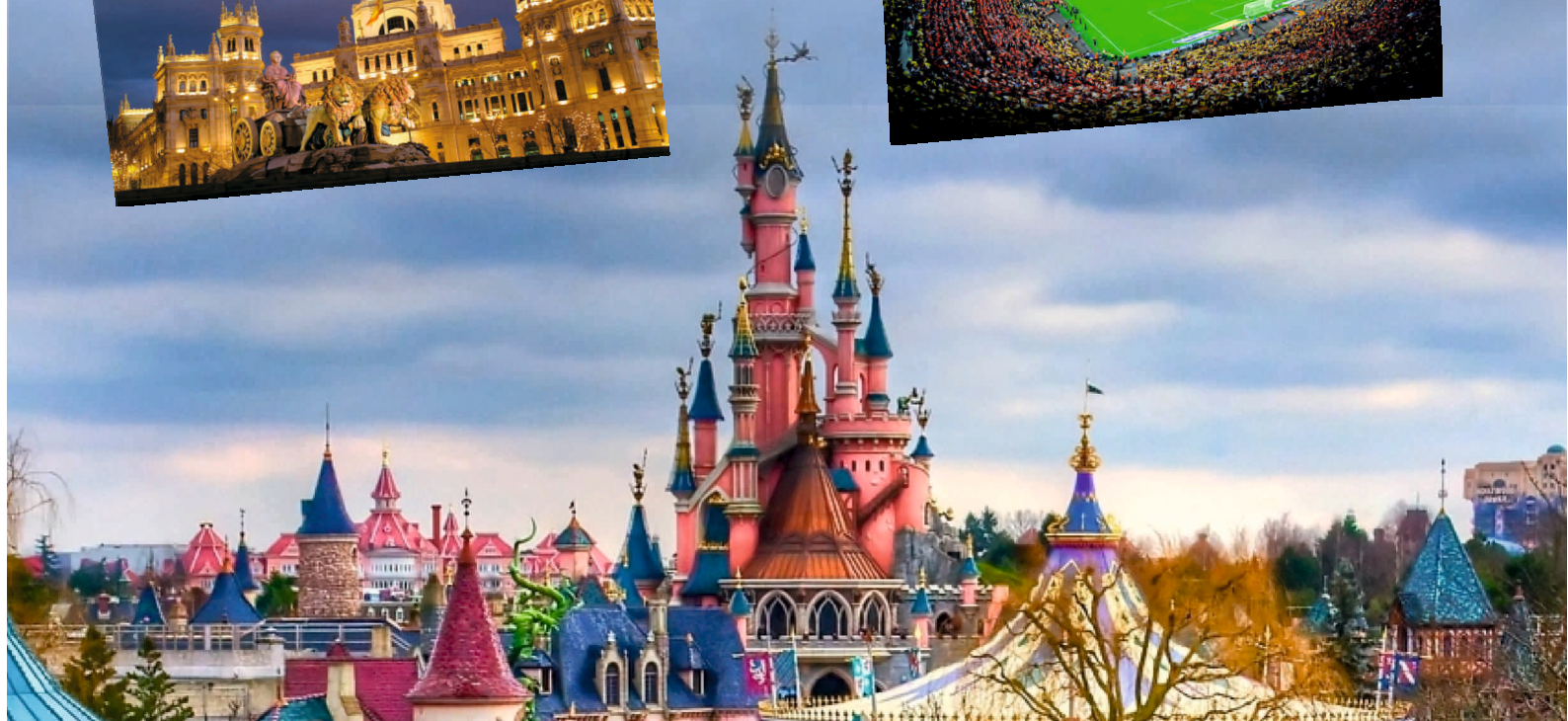

FRANCE

PARIS



Paris is known throughout the world as the "City of Lights," Paris is celebrated for its beautiful city plan, its architecture, museums, bridges, cathedrals, parks, shopping, flea markets, sidewalk cafés, wide and luxurious boulevards, elegant cuisine, and numerous monuments notable the immaculate Tour Eiffel, symbol of France. An island in the middle of the Seine River, the Ile de la Cité, Paris, founded more than 2,000 years ago, quickly spread to both banks of the river.

PARIS DISNEYLAND



Disneyland Paris is a must-visit, and is just 35 minutes from Paris. The theme park opened in 1992 in Marne-la-Vallée, and is the most visited attraction of its kind in Europe. Built by The Walt Disney Company. The entertainment behemoth boasts no fewer than 52 attractions on a 55-hectare site.

SPAIN BARCELONA



In 410 AD, after sacking Rome the Germanic Visigoths swept into Spain, renaming the city from Catalunya to Barcelona and making it their capital between 531 and 554 until they moved to Toledo. The Visigoth kingdom came to an end in 711 with the Moorish invasion from Africa and Catalunya was briefly overrun until defeated beyond the Pyrenees by the Franks in 732. Barcelona acted as the focal point for the exchange of scholar and scientific knowledge between the European and Muslim worlds and the arts flourished under the great patronage. Foreign trade saw to it that shipbuilding and conquest were established.

MADRID



It is now commonly believed that the original name of the settlement here was Matrice, a pre-Muslim word, which refers to the waters of the area and particularly to the stream running down the Calle de Segovia. Since then Madrid's urban progress has accelerated to reach, today, the level of one of Europe's most beautiful capital cities - pleasing both for its intense animated spirit and its suitable mix of

modern and classical appearance.

PORTUGAL PORTO



The Historic Centre of Oporto or Porto is a commercial port that has been looking to the west for its trade for over 1000 years. The nominated area is enclosed within the 14th century city walls. The city is situated along the river Douro, which has three impressive bridges (one of these, the Ponte de Doña Maria Pia, was built in 1877 by Gustave Eiffel). One of the most impressive buildings is the Torre dos Clerigos, the highest tower in Portugal measuring 76 meters. It was built between 1754 and 1763, under supervision of the architect Nicolau Nazoni. You can climb the granite tower via 200 steps.

LISBON



The age of discovery, from the 15th to the 18th century, marked the Enchanted Port as the main departure point of the Portuguese discovery expeditions. Explorers sailed from this city in the entire world, discovering new lands in South America, Africa, and Vasco De Gama was the first European to link Europe to Asia founded the first sea route to India This made Portugal one

of the ruling nations of Europe, while Lisbon was Europe's most prosperous trading center.

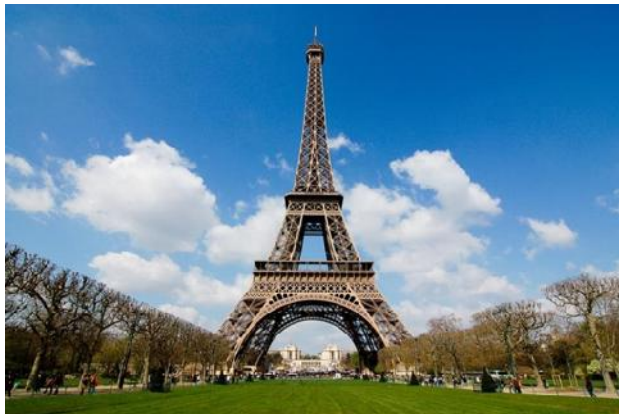
PROGRAM DETAILS

DAY 01
NEW DELHI /PARIS/PARIS



You will be received at Roissy Charles De Gaulle Airport. After customs clearance you will be transferred by Coach directly to your Hotel. Free to Rest and Overnight at the Hotel

DAY 02
PARIS / PARIS CITY TOUR



After breakfast we will begin on the southern bank of the Seine to have 360° panorama of Paris most famous sights from the Place de la Concorde with view of the Eiffel tower, the seine and along the champ Elysées. We will stroll through the Hotel des invalids, which includes a military museum and Napoleon's tomb. An hour-long cruise onboard a glass-topped boat. An unique opportunity to see Paris and its history and discover the beautiful banks of the Seine, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Have our lunch in one of the most beautiful parks in the vicinity.

We will visit the symbol and pride of France the Eiffel Tower. Lifts yo-yo up and down the north, west and east pillars of Paris' signature tower; change lifts on the 2nd floor for the final ascent to the top. After our visit we will move over to the Latin quarter (so named because university students here communicated in Latin until the French Revolution), the centre of academic life in Paris. We will proceed to St-Germain des Prés. Literary lovers, antique collectors and fashionistas

all flock to this mythological part of Paris. Today's St-Germain des Prés accommodates exclusive home wares and clothing boutiques, though the original literary cafés still exist. Later you will be transferred to the restaurant for dinner. After dinner return to hotel. Overnight in hotel.

DAY 03

PARIS / DISNEYLAND ADVENTURE



After breakfast we will depart to Disneyland Park 2 for fun full experience of your favorite Disney characters. At Disneyland Park you can enjoy rides and attractions such as Space Mountain, Phantom Manor, Pirates of the Caribbean, Big Thunder Mountain, It's a Small World and much, much more and at Walt Disney Studios you can live the behind the scenes with magic films, television, animation and entertainment . At around 7.30 pm we will depart back to Paris City for an Indian dinner. After dinner if time permits we will cover some must see places at night. Later transfer to the hotel. Overnight at hotel.

DAY 04

PARIS / PARIS CULTURAL TOUR



After breakfast we will depart today to visit the world famous Louvre through I M Pei Glass and Iron pyramid. Spend three hours with an expert guide, seeing and learning about some of the museum's 35,000 artworks across eight themed galleries. The Louvre offers something for everyone including Venus de Milo and Mona Lisa. In the afternoon we will have a quick Lunch in the lively surrounding of Paris. After Lunch you will head out to the outskirts of Paris of Paris visit the famous Chateau de Versailles.



The King's Grand Apartment, this prestigious seven-room enfilade was meant to serve as a parade apartment, that is, as a venue for the sovereign's official acts. Therefore it was sumptuously decorated according to the model of former Italian palaces. The Hall of Mirrors or "the Grande Galerie", as it was called in the 17th century, was used daily as a place of passage, and a waiting and meeting space for the courtiers and the visiting public. The Queen's chamber, the chamber is the main room of the apartment, the one where the Queen spent most of her time. The Palace of Versailles, or simply Versailles. It is also known as the Château de Versailles. When the château was built, Versailles was a country village; today, however, it is a wealthy suburb of Paris, some 20 kilometers southwest of the French capital.

DAY 05
PARIS-BARCELONA



After breakfast you will say bye to Paris and its magic. You will be transferred to Gare du Lyon train station to board your train to Barcelona which will leave Gare De Lyon Station at 07h 15 and will arrive in Barcelona at 13h30. You will be transferred to your hotel for check in and refreshment.

You will leave at 17h00 to the famous Passeig de Gràcia avenue. It is Barcelona's most elegant avenue and one of the best architectural walks in the city with lots of Modernist buildings (la Casa Batlló, La Casa Milà...).



Aside from being one of the best places to see Catalan Modernist architecture, this avenue is one of the major streets for shopping in Barcelona. Later in the evening you will be transferred for dinner to an Indian restaurant. After dinner transfer to Hotel. Overnight in Hotel.

DAY 06

BARCELONA/BARCELONA

The idea of this Full Day Tour of Barcelona is to enjoy the best of two worlds: a driving tour in the morning to visit the sites that require transport to be reached and an afternoon walking tour of the Old Town (Casc Antic), which is a pedestrian-only area and must be seen on foot only.



The morning driving tour will be taking you along Barcelona's main avenues and landmarks. The tour also allows for a detailed visit of Barcelona's main monument and architect Gaudí's master

piece: the Sagrada Familia church above photo (interior visit optional).



After lunch, we will be visiting the Soccer Stadium of Barcelona. The Barcelona football stadium is the 3rd largest football stadium in the World after the stadiums in Sao Paulo, Brazil and Mexico City. Barcelona Camp Nou has a capacity of 110,000 people and on every match practically every seat is taken -such is the passion for football shared by the Catalan people. Its narrow (and sometimes even very narrow) streets are now lined by trendy boutiques, cafés and restaurants, museums and art galleries. It will also be a perfect spot to end the tour as you will want to linger on for a soft drink, a couple of tapas and window-shopping. Later in the evening you will be transferred to dinner to an Indian Restaurant. After dinner you will be transferred to your Hotel. Overnight in the hotel.

DAY 07

BARCELONA/MADRID

After breakfast you will leave by Barcelona to Madrid by coach. On arrival you will check into your hotel. Later after refreshments, you will board your coach for an orientation Tour of Madrid.



At around 15h00 for an evening tour of the city. Start with a panoramic drive to see the most important monuments Continue into the Old Quarter for a stroll including the Plaza Mayor and the

San Miguel Market. The Prado Museum houses one of the finest art collections in the world. The Thyssen Museum houses the private collection of the Baron Von Thyssen as well as an entire annex dedicated to the Baroness's private collection containing a good example of Impressionist art. The Reina Sofia Contemporary Art Center is where Picasso's Guernica is housed. Once a historic hospital, it now boasts a new addition designed by Jean Nouvel, the French architect known for his work on the Cartier Foundation. The Royal Palace was built by the Spanish Bourbon monarchy. The visit includes the Royal Pharmacy, state apartments, armory and chapel. Later you will be taken for your dinner to an Indian restaurant. After dinner transfer to your hotel. Overnight stay in the hotel.

DAY 08

MADRID-PORTO /PORTUGAL

Porto's historic centre is the Ribeira district, a Unesco World Heritage Site where tripeiros (Porto residents) mingle before old storefronts, on village-style plazas and in the old houses of commerce where Roman ruins lurk beneath the foundations.



After breakfast you will prepare for an early check out you will leave Madrid to Porto in Portugal. The journey would take 5hrs 30 mins. On arrival in Portugal you will check into your hotel for some rest and refreshments. In the Afternoon, you will be guided for a visit to the city of Porto : the Church of St. Francisco , "Palácio da Bolsa" , "Rotunda da Boavista" , "Castelo de Queijo" Later in the evening at 19h30 transfer for dinner. After dinner return to the Hotel. Overnight in the hotel.



We will start going through the main city Avenue named Aliados, which is considered the "Living Room" of the city with plenty of important monuments and where portuguese people focus to celebrate special moments.

After that you are going to see Bolhão Market that is the most emblematic market in the city with two floors and that the locals use to go to buy daily and fresh products. Later we will tour the major touristic Oporto spots, passing by Batalha Square, Santa Catarina Street which is the most commercial artery of downtown Porto, with much of it now forbidden to traffic and reserved only for pedestrians. You will have the opportunity to visit the famous and traditional Cafe Majestic, where in the biography of JK Rowling written by Sean Smith who refers that the writer spent much time at Cafe Majestic working on the first book "Harry Potter and the Sorcerer's Stone"

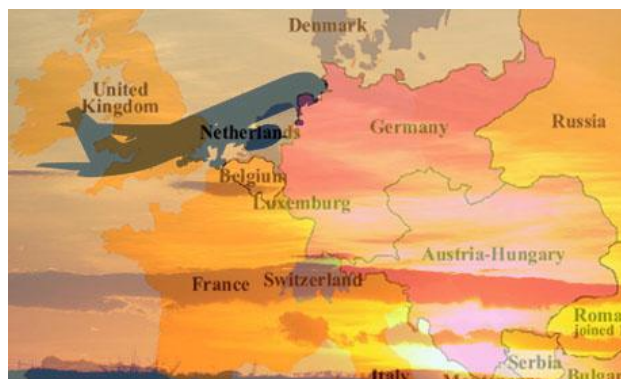
After lunch in one of the many outlets you will be amazed when we will visit the Lello Bookstore with its unique historical and artistic value, Later we will go to see some of the city's modern attraction that is Dom Luis I Bridge - an iron bridge that was engineered by one of the apprentices of Gustave Eiffel. You will be amazed by the classic Rabelo's boats (flat-bottomed cargo vessels) lined up along the quay. Later in the evening you will be taken for dinner. After dinner you will be transferred to your hotel. Overnight in the hotel.

DAY 10
PORTO-LISBON



After breakfast you will check out of your hotel on your way to Lisbon.

Spread across steep hillsides that overlook the Rio Tejo, Lisbon has captivated visitors for centuries. Windswept vistas reveal the city in all its beauty: Roman and Moorish ruins, white-domed cathedrals, grand plazas lined with sun-drenched cafes. The real delight of discovery though, is delving into the narrow cobblestone lanes. As yellow trams clatter through tree-lined streets, lisboétas stroll through lamplit old quarters, much as they've done for centuries. Gossip is exchanged over fresh bread and wine at tiny patio restaurants as fado singers perform in the background. In other parts of town, Lisbon reveals her youthful alter ego at bohemian bars and riverside clubs, late-night street parties and eye-catching boutiques selling all things classic and cutting-edge. You will be taken for brief orientation tour of Lisbon. After Lunch you will be transferred to Lisbon Airport for your onward journey to Delhi



You will be guided to your terminal for on board customs clearances and you will take your flight for your onboard journey to Delhi.
